Cohistan in Persian, meaning "land of mountains" has




historic and geographic sense, Kohistan is used for a region that stretches from the border with Azad Kashmir in the east to Afghanistan's Nuristan province in the west.


Kohistan has a rich local history as a crossroads between Central, South and Southwestern Asia. Predominantly inhabited by Dardic and Pashtun tribes since ancient times, Kohistan has been invaded and contested by Persians, Greeks, Scythians, Kushans, Turks, Afghans, Mughals, and the British.

The function of education is to bring change in child behavior and







personality in a more desirable form. Development of child's body and mind demand proper nurturing of its physical and intellectual qualities as few of the major determinants of his personality. Therefore, modern approaches of education emphasize on all round development of the child.

Learning and teaching occur when there is proper environment for it. A good functional school is that, where there is a conducive place of learning and that means the roofs are not leaking, the paint are not peeling off the walls and ceilings, the drains are not clogged, the gym roof is not leaking, the showers have water when we need it, proper school and class room management, community active participation, proper educational environment and everything is running smoothly. To put it simply, quality education is directly associated with the quality of the facilities and building. The school is one of the most vital organizations in our society and one structure carries some of our fondest memories. It also has an enormous influence in our lives, in our individualities and our views and perceptions of the world. That's why Salik Foundation felt the educational problems of Kohistan and launched "Education Improvement

He told that Salik Foundation arranged capacity building trainings for the teachers in Kohistan. In short Salik Foundation worked hard and provided appropriate educational environment in all its listed school".

Project Goal and Objectives

Salik Foundation with the collaboration of Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund launched "Education Improvement Program Kohistan" with the belief to provided appropriate educational environment in Kohistan. The goal of the project (Education Improvement) is to demonstrate that provision of good quality education in rural areas is possible and good education can be instrumental in bringing about overall positive change in Kohistan. This goal is very much in line with Salik Development Foundation's mission of mainstreaming and marginalized through various approaches to human and institutional development.

From a philosophical perspective, people living in democratic societies have a right to a direct and meaningful voice about issues and services that affect them. At a practical level, many of the problems that affect the combine well-being of

people in communities—such as substance abuse, poverty, environmental hazards, obesity, and inadequate access to care and terrorism—cannot be solved by any person, organization, or sector working alone. These problems are complex and interrelated, defying easy answers. They affect diverse populations and occur in many different kinds of local contexts. The local context, in turn, is dependent on decisions made at state, national, and international levels. Only by combining the knowledge, skills, and resources of a broad array of people and organizations can communities understand the underlying nature of these problems and develop effective and locally feasible solutions to address them.

Salik Foundation organized the people and involved them, to work in an organized way. For this purpose Salik Foundation conducted community broad base meetings to aware the people about the education improvement program. So people welcomed Salik Foundation and worked hard for the education improvement in Kohistan. The main theme of Salik Foundation is to involve the community for Education improvement in Kohistan i.e.

Provision of Educational Materials (Teaching AIDs, Science Equipment's etc), fixture, furniture for Students and School Staff

Salik Foundation provided appropriate educational materials to schools which highly influenced the teaching and learning ways amongst the students and teachers. Educational materials are provided to 12 schools and science equipment's are provided to 5 schools respectively.

Salik Foundation provided necessary fixtures (Lights, Fans and Holders etc), furniture for students (Desks/Benches) and staff furniture (Tables/Chairs), to 12 schools respectively.

Teaching AIDs play a very eminent role in education improvement. Salik Foundation (Education Specialist) provided teaching AIDs to 30 schools. Teaching AIDs including learning kits, stationary, Registers for teachers students and common registers, white boards, black boards, charts (color/white), pencils, ball points, chalks, color pencils etc.


