

The Government of Khyber Pukhtonkhwa initiated a Program named Sehat Sahulat Program for the marginalized segments of the province. The main objective of the initiative was to insure the health facilities at the door steps to all the marginalized dwellers of the province. For this purpose data from Benezir income support program has been obtained and up to 25 scores families were selected for the provision of sehat insaf Card.

In this regards STATE LIFE INSURANCE CORPORATION OF PAKISTAN has signed an agreement with Project Management Unit, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for providing Hospitalization facilities to the marginalized segments of population from the designated districts. The data of the pre-selected families were provided by the KP government for issuance of health cards to the selected households. The main reason of health cards is to provide and insure inpatient/daycare facilities in the designated public and private hospitals of the districts.




The primary task of the SDF is the distribution of the health cards along with printed material and spreading awareness among the card holders regarding acquisition of health care facilities while admitted in the hospital.

# Key projects brief in the reporting period:

In this Annual report we strived to incorporate all the components and project we accomplished successfully, here is some of the brief introduction and achievements of the projects in 2017-18.

## Sehat Sahulat Program (Sehat Insaf Card) & Prime Minister National Health Program (PMNHP) **“Social health protection initiative”**

### Executive Summary of the project

**T**hrough proposed project named “Social Health protection Initiative, SEHAT SAHULAT PROGRAM” & Prime Minister National Health Program (PMNHP), and is being implementing by SDF with the technical and financial support of State life insurance corporation was designed this year to facilitate 353251 marginalized families.

The main focus of the project was to aware and mobilize the targeted community regarding health card facility and how to use, while on other hand the core responsibility of SDF was to distribute 353251 Numbers of health cards to the selected project participants.

The duration of the project was initially of 10 months while it was extended to 02 more months. The targeted area of the project was twelve districts in KPK, district Mardan, Sawabi, Charsadda and District Haripur in Punjab Province District Sargodha, Baluchistan Province District Quetta, in FATA Bajaur Agency and Khyber Agency, in AJK District Kotli & Muzafarabad, In GB Diamar & Skardu.

In the project spam all the activities were carried out very professionally and all the SOPs were carried out very well.

To achieve the desired objectives SOPs were designed keeping all the requirement of the donor. SDF give the advertisement for hiring teams, and all the recruitment process was carried out professionally. A total of 16 teams were hired and each team was comprised of 05 personnel.

The core task assigned to the team leader was to coordinate with focal persons, the list of whom were provided by the CM secretariat, while it was endorsed by the local MPAs and MNAs.

The team leaders along with their team were thoroughly briefed on the project and task were assigned to each team, the team leader along with their team prepare their implementation plan and present in the orientation session.

The necessary equipments were provided along with vehicles to each team, and after the contract signing activity they starts their activity according to plan.

Initially it was very difficult to achieve the desired target as per the SOP shared by the donor, so with mutual discussion with the high ups, focal persons and other philanthropists were involved to expedite the process, which was proved fruitful afterward.

This report presents the extract of all the accomplished project’s activities named “*Social Health protection Initiative, SEHAT SAHULAT PROGRAM & PRIME MINISTER NATIONAL HEALTH PROGRAM*”.

This project consumed huge amount of work, research and dedication. Still, implementation would not have been possible if we did not have a support of many individuals and experts. Therefore we would like to extend our sincere gratitude to all of them.

The report doesn’t reflect the involvement and interest of the KP government and all the elected members, here we are including some of the pictures, shows the presence of Speaker, deputy Speaker, MPAs, MNAs, Ministers in the inauguration and monitoring visits to different CDCs established by Salik Development Foundation in twelve targeted districts from KPK, district Mardan, Sawabi, Charsadda and District Haripur in Punjab Province District Sargodha, Baluchistan Province District Quetta, in FATA Bajaur Agency and Khyber Agency, in AJK District Kotli & Muzafarabad, In GB Diamar & Skardu. The project was very fruitful and interesting, and was according to the dire need of the beneficiaries.

## PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION:

Salik Development Foundation (SDF) signed an agreement with State Life for Card distribution in four districts from KPK, district Mardan, Sawabi, Charsadda and Haripur in Punjab Province District Sargodha, In Baluchistan Province District Quetta, in FATA Bajaur Agency and Khyber Agency, in AJK District Kotli & Muzafarabad, In GB Diamar & Skardu. Main Responsibility of SDF was the enrollment of beneficiaries and updating the family tree of the remaining and new beneficiaries roster contact numbers to the software. It was also decided in the contract with the donor to distribute Health cards to



the targeted beneficiaries. As this was the second phase of the project, hence all the team leaders were called for the introductory meeting, and Detail implementation plan was developed for the whole project.

The Team leaders were asked to share their lesson learned from the previous phase, while the SDF staff also shared the challenges and the recommendation to the team leaders.

Some Team leaders who delivered their best in the previous phase were offered for District coordinators, while some computer operators were offered to perform their services as team leaders.



After the designing of DIP, the team leaders were asked to hire a team for the field interventions and they must get an orientation session in the current month.

All the methodology adopted was shared with the donor and they appreciate the efforts, and also assured In this connection SDF started its project from Swabi with close coordination of all the relevant stack holders.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> phase of PMNHP and SSP programs were started in July 2017 in all of the targeted districts of Pakistan, which is mentioned above in this report.

The overall project was monitored and visited by different elected and official members, and they appreciate the work and arrangement.

In some new places proper inauguration ceremony was held at district or tehsil level in all three provinces including FATA & GB.

In these inaugurations all the relevant stack holders of the districts were invited while focal persons were also invited in each district respectively. All the focal persons were thoroughly briefed about the program and their contacts numbers were noted for correspondence and support.

Each district cards were bifurcated union councils wise and the cards and tokens received from state life were also kept properly on the basis of union

councils.

The staff was hired for each district as bellow, and they were briefed on the operating procedures/ Methodology, project orientation were carried out in the SDF head office, relevant district focal premises and areas were assigned to each team leader with clear SOPs.

Each team was comprised of the following personnel.

1. Team Leader
2. Social Mobilizer Male/Female
3. Computer Operators
4. Card sorting officer
5. Driver




State Life Insurance Corporation of Pakistan provided the data of selected beneficiaries in all these four districts of KPK. SDF made a Detail implementation plan for sehat Sahulat program of all these four district of KPK. The entire relevant stack holders were kept in loop. Following are the main steps taken for program implementation.

## 1 -Project summary

### - Project OVERVIEW and Objectives

**S**alik Development Foundation is working in district Mardan since 1989 and has a wide network of social mobilization. SDF has organized thousands of households in District Mardan. As clean drinking water is the dire need of every person in our dear country Pakistan. As per survey conducted in the UC Pir Saddi and Seri Behlol, MahalMakori, Narai & Kot Jungara there are approximately four hindered household who have no access to clean drinking water. In this connection SDF with the financial support of Penny Appeal Pakistan as per set criteria initially selected 50 HHs for installation of hand Pumps at their home premises. For this purpose initially the village development Committee has identified those HHs which have no clean drinking water facility at their homes premises. These HH has to bring water from neighbors, masjids or hujra. Most of these households' heads are aged or women.

#### Objectives

1. Extremely Vulnerable communities provided with safe water for drinking through the installation of HH hand pump.
2. Improved Hygienic practices through community involvement and awareness raising

As Per agreement with the penny Appeal Pakistan SDF selected the targeted villages as per consultation with the Municipal Committee Takht Bhai and carried out a detail survey in the above mentioned UCs. In these villages there is no water supply scheme by the TMA. Initially SDF formed a village development committee in the mention village for the identification of beneficiaries as per criteria. SDF initially identified 47 HHs in Village Pir saddi and 03 HHs in Village Dako Baba. In the mean time SDF keep the district Administration in loop for courtesy and support. SDF engineer also carried out technical survey in the target villages for water testing from Pakistan Council of scientific and industrial research (PCRWR)Peshawar, who declared that the water is clean and safe for drinking purpose. The Procurement of contractor was also completed through



proper procurement procedure of SDF and after the finalization of the contractor signed an agreement with the contractor for installation of Hand Pumps in above mentioned villages . The Program was implemented in UC Pir Saddi and Seri Behlol, Mahal Makory, narai & Kot Jungara UCs of Tehsil Takht Bhai District Mardan Khyber Pukhtoonkhwa

The formation of the village committees was established for the selection of beneficiaries as per set criteria of SDF and Penny Appeal Pakistan. The Main Criteria for hand Pump Installation was that they have no source of water in their home premises and are dependent for water on others, Financially Weak, widows and orphans and according to vulnerability of the family. Once all the beneficiaries selected then the name of the beneficiaries was shared with SDF for confirmation and visit to individual beneficiaries

The VDC formed in the village were independent in selection of beneficiaries for thirst Relief. They were also involved in the decisions regarding finalization of the Hand Pumps Location and other implementation strategy of the thirst relief Project. The Members of VDCs have also nominations form the elected members of local government. (Nazims, Naib Nazims and Beneficiaries of thirst Relief Project). These persons were actively involved in project implementation from start till the completion of the thirst relief project. They have selected the beneficiaries for thirst relief project as per criteria, conducted health and hygiene sessions, Training on Hand Pumps repair, Selection of Hand Pump site.



Thirst Relief Project with Financial Support of Penny Appeal Pakistan Has main implementation steps are as Follows. The First Step was the formation of Village Development Committees (VDCs) and Identification of targeted beneficiaries in the targeted villages of selected UCs. After beneficiary identification and procurement for the hand Pumps installation SDF team lay-out for the hand pumps and briefing of the contractor to work as per the approved design from Penny Appeal Pakistan. 

## - Health & Hygiene sessions

During the implementation of the Penny Appeal project, Health & Hygiene sessions were also conducted by the H&H officer in the targeted area.

Initially in the first phase of the project a sum of 12 sessions were conducted in the targeted UCs, Including schools, Hujras, and Household level.

The need of the Health and Hygiene session were came to know through the survey conducted by SDF, before the start of the project.

The survey main finding regarding current practices for Health & Hygiene were as bellow;

1. Poor maintenance and use of water storage containers. Appropriate behaviors were not observed in the maintenance of water containers and in the way in which water was drawn from the containers. A large cup was usually used to draw water from various kinds of drinking water containers, most without covers. When water was extracted, fingers came in contact with the water. Also, water containers were not kept clean.
2. Inadequate hand washing practices. People washed in the cup used to draw water from the container or poured water over both hands. Hands were air dried, although women sometimes dried their hands on their aprons. Soap was not always available, and, when it was, it was generally an all purpose soap or detergent. ,,
3. No hand washing places. Most homes did not have a place reserved for washing hands; people washed where kitchen utensils were washed. ,,
4. No latrines. Most homes had no latrines, and household members defecated in the fields. ,,
5. Use of disposable diapers. Despite the poverty of most households, residents made widespread use of disposable diapers. In some cases they were washed and reused; they were generally disposed of by throwing them in a field. ,, No garbage collection. There was no garbage collection service, and some households were in the habit of burning their trash. ,,
6. Poor economic conditions. One of the most significant obstacles to a more hygienic use of water was the poor economic situation of the families, who depended on sporadic work for agricultural firms. It was difficult for them to afford adequate water storage containers and other items, such as soap and toilet paper.



Keeping in view the above facts SDF, starts campaign for Safe Health & Hygiene practices, Hence more than 16 sessions were conducted in different premises with different sect of life.

Small booklets, comprising of best practices with pictures were shared with the beneficiaries along with multimedia movies clips to aware the targeted beneficiaries in the targeted area of intervention.

SDF is striving to ensure bellow chart in the community.

**Food Hygiene** – Main source is raw food . Targeted hygiene is:

- safe cooking, safe storage AND -
- preventing cross contamination via **hands, surfaces and cloths** immediately after handling raw foods/before handling ready to eat foods

**Respiratory hygiene** Source is infected people. Targeted hygiene is:

- catching snot & sneezes etc into a handkerchief/tissue,
- disposing of tissues etc safely
- then **washing hands**
- knowing the virus spreads via **hands & surfaces** as well as **air**

**Hand hygiene** is central to all hygiene practices. Infection occurs by touching the mouth, cuts, wounds, nose & eyes with contaminated hands.

**Toilet hygiene:** Source is “poo” from infected & healthy people. Targeted hygiene is:

- Wash hands** after toilet visits
- Keep toilet clean – inc. touch **surfaces (flush handle, lid etc)**
- Clean and dry **cleaning utensils** after use
- Wash hands** after cleaning toilet

**Laundry hygiene:** Source is people, food, domestic animals. Targeted hygiene is:


- Laundering risk items using wash cycles that effectively remove microbes & prevent transfer to other items in wash load
- **Wash hands** after handling soiled laundry

## Back Ground of Tahreek Tanaziat Muqadmat Khatima:

The conventional court system of Pakistan, today, finds itself embroiled in a myriad of structural and administrative issues.

The civil courts too are excessively overburdened and under-resourced. Therefore, Whenever petty issues involving non-cognizable offences get forwarded to civil courts from the Police, the involved parties find themselves following a long and expensive process of justice. The delay in dispensation of justice, if at all dispensed, causes a feeling of frustration, humiliation and despondency.

Moreover, since such issues (mostly of civil nature) do not get timely resolved, they usually end up in a criminal activity with the aggrieved party taking the law in its own hands. A petty wage issue turns into a criminal act when the aggrieved person attacks the owner. Similarly, a simple divorce or custody issue often ends up resulting in a spate of murders.

Pakistan is an Islamic republic state.

Many kinds of Followers are residing over here. As Per constitution every citizen has equal rights over here. As per practice Minority and Majority both are suffering for lacking of basic needs of Life. The lack of basic needs have many reasons but one of the main is the out dated system in place in this country. The citizens and Departments of this country are feel sorry for each other which is creating more and more disputes. The system for resolving these disputes need

improvement. The current system wasting time, resources and human as well. The lengthy process lasted for generation to generation and creating more and more disputes. The People coming for justice to courts fall in unending difficulties and problems. They forgot the cruelty upon them for which they are seeking justice in the courts. In the end they pray for finishing the cases. Millions of cases suffering billion of peoples are still pending to be decided.



The current system is promoting poverty, illiteracy and disputes, which is creating hurdles for promoting a peaceful, developed and prosperous society. The responsibility cannot be shifted to the staff and employees of this sector because in this most of the staff is devoted and intelligent. These all are our children and elders and also production of our society. As a Pakistan we all are responsible for not changing ir improving the system of justice in placed.



Keeping in view the above situation a need was felt for a movement to settle down all the issues and disputes outside from respectable courts. Definitely the people victims of this system need a safe exit from disputes and cases but they have never provided a neutral and sincere platform for the issues resolution without biasness. So a movement has been initiated for this purpose. In this movement every person should devote on hour after JUMMA Prayer for voluntarily for ALLAH. They will solve the disputes within their family, Mohallah, Street and city whichever is feasible of them.

In this program, which is initiated by SDF on self finance, is now a part of dispute resolution council, where president of SDF is voluntarily offer his services once in a week for the amicable resolution of the cases forwarded by the requestors.

In the previous year 2017-18 more than 734 applications were reported, in which 606 were resolved while 78 were referred for legal action, while 50 cases are in progress.

As per SDF customs, it is decided that in TTMK, those who perform best will get a reward of one umrah Ticket from SDF.

In the previous year an Umrah ticket was awarded to Mr. Hafeezul Wahab for resolving more issues in the year.

He took an active part in the resolution of 17 disputes of different contexts. His efforts were appreciated by the participants and pray for the better and bright future of TTMK.
